

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

On May 15th, we want as many students as possible to **simply not show up at class all day** and instead **join us for a protest at 2 pm in Janskerkhof**.

Make sure to let your teachers know why you will not show up, and try to get your course mates to join you at the protest: in this way, we show that there is a large group of students who care about their university's policy on Palestine and Israel's human rights violations.

In the morning before the protest, **you can organize activities yourself**. Think for example about organizing a reading group to educate yourself about Palestine; creating a sign and banner making space; or anything else you can come up with! Let us know about your ideas and we will try to support you in making it happen.

THE DEMANDS OF THE STRIKE TO THE UNIVERSITY

- **Boycott and Divest.** Stop ongoing and future research collaborations between Utrecht University and Israeli unis and companies.
- **Neutrality is complicity.** Recognize what is happening in Gaza as a genocide and call for an immediate ceasefire.
- **No more business as usual.** Develop a policy to review the human rights records of research, exchange, and commercial partners of the university. **Be transparent** about the university's ties with human rights offenders, in Israel and elsewhere.
- **Dissent is what democracy looks like.** Do not suppress and silence the voices of students and staff standing for Palestine.
- **Equity needs action.** Support your Palestinian and Arab staff and students in this time.
