In January of this year, the International Court of Justice ruled that a "plausible genocide" is being committed in Gaza.

Unabated, Israel continues its onslaught on Palestinian people, including the complete destruction of the educational system in Gaza. We invite students and staff of Utrecht University, as well as other universities, and all other concerned citizens to discuss "the university's" response and responsibility in the face of an unfolding genocide. How should a university respond to the International Court's recent ruling? What role does the university have in shaping public debate and in upholding the principles of human rights and justice for all, Palestinians being no exception? In the context of a "plausible genocide," should a university remain "neutral"? If not, what can we do, as scholars, students, and citizens, when our universities go silent, or worse, silence academic freedom?
